



DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

“ROMA TRE UNIVERSITY”

AND

FEDERAL STATE-FUNDED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION

“FINANCIAL UNIVERSITY

UNDER

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION”

Roma Tre University, represented by the Rector Prof. Luca Pietromarchi, appointed with ministerial decree n.856.30-10-2017, and the Federal State-Funded Educational Institution of Higher Education “Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation”, represented by the Vice-Rector for International Cooperation, Prof. Alexander S. Linnikov, acting in accordance with Power of Attorney No. 114/48 of 1 January 2021, hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Parties”

AGREE

to sign a Double Degree Program “Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer)” that will culminate in the award of an Italian-Russian Master Degree for the students selected to carry out the study program as described in this agreement.

Art. 1: Purpose

This Agreement will provide to the Financial University and Roma Tre University students an opportunity of obtaining an Italian-Russian Double Degree, namely, the Italian Laurea Magistrale in Law (LMG/01) of the Faculty of Law of the Roma Tre University and the Russian Master Degree (program in Law No. 40.04.01), with the concentration in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer) of the Faculty of Law of the Financial University. Each Degree is fully and automatically recognized by both Universities.

The intended period of study for the Double Degree Program shall be two years (Master Degree of the Faculty of Law of the Financial University (program in Law No. 40.04.01), with the concentration in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer) – year 1 and 2; and Master Degree of the Roma Tre University - Laurea Magistrale – Global Legal Studies curriculum – year 4 and 5). Upon successful completion of the relevant courses and formative assessment tests, students will obtain reciprocal recognition of credits earned for the required and elective courses in accordance with the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

The Program will be implemented from the academic year 2022/2023, upon successful completion of the requirements set forth by the Parties.

This Double Degree Program stems from the desire of its signatories to foster the internationalization of studies, notably within the Council of Europe and with regard to the relevant legal professions (judges, lawyers, professors and researchers of multinational companies, international institutions, Russian and European institutions).

Each Party shall adopt, in accordance with the objectives of this Agreement, internal

rules of procedure for the functioning of the Program in the institution of the Party, which must be forwarded to the partner institution for information purposes.

Each Party shall ensure the promotion of the Double Degree Program and of its main organizational aspects through its website.

Art. 2: Pre-Selection Requirements

Candidates for the Double Degree Program shall be selected by both Parties in accordance with the jointly defined and agreed upon selection criteria and the list of candidates shall be sent by the Party Program Coordinator to the other Party for consideration and making the final enrolment resolution.

The student evaluation criteria, the academic staff selection criteria and the criteria used for the establishment of the boards assessing the final examination are set by the host institutions independently.

In order to be eligible for participation in the Program, students must, as a minimum, meet the following criteria:

A) The Financial University students should:

- Hold a Bachelor of Law (program No. 40.03.01 in Law) awarded by a Russian university (240 ECTS credits);
- Be enrolled in the Master Degree (program in Law No. 40.04.01), with the concentration in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer);
- Have English language skills at CEFR level B2 or higher, which should be certified by an appropriate international language certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) or a certificate issued by the home institution.

B) The Roma Tre University students should:

- Be enrolled to the Laurea Magistrale in Law (LMG/01) at the Roma Tre University and have obtained at least 180 ECTS credits;
- Have English language skills at CEFR level B2 or higher, which should be certified by an appropriate international language certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) or a certificate issued by the home institution.

Art. 3: Selection and Number of Students

The selection procedure at Roma Tre University will be carried out between September and December each year among all students who have satisfactorily completed all the required courses and examinations of the first two years and are attending the third year of the Laurea Magistrale in Law (LMG/01). The students who have passed the selection procedure are required to take the exam of Civil Procedure Law during their third year.

The selection procedure at Financial University will be carried out in November each year among the first-year students of the master degree program in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer) who have passed the formative assessment tests at the end of Module 1 and meet the above criteria as per the procedure established in the Financial University by-laws.

Scanned copied of documents required by each of the Parties for preliminary registration shall be submitted not later than 30 November each year. The list of documents is set in the Annex A and can be amended by the Parties mutual consent. Originals of the documents required by each of the Parties for the registration purposes shall be submitted not later than on 15 December of the current year.

As a rule, not more than 5 students from each of the Parties can participate in the Program each year. The Parties agree to discuss the number of the Program student participants each year and adjust the quota established using the parity principle.

Art. 4: Students Rights and Obligations

Students enjoy full rights and status both in the home and host institution. During their stay at the host institution, students will be subject to all internal rules of the host institution and to all legislative and social obligations of the host country.

During the study period abroad, students are alone responsible for covering personal expenses, such as living costs, housing, transportation, study materials and an adequate health insurance, which is mandatory for the enrolment at the host institution.

The host institution will give the participating students assistance in finding accommodation, if desired and possible.

Art. 5: Organisation

Students admitted to the Program shall be registered as students both at their home institution and at the host institution. Students will obtain tuition fee waivers at the host institution. The tuition fee payment procedure and other fee payment procedure (if available) at the home institution shall be regulated by the relevant Party by-laws.

The students selected by Roma Tre University as Program participants shall attend the second semester at the Financial University for the first year of the Double Degree (Roma Tre University Laurea Magistrale - year 4); and the first semester for the second year of the Double Degree (Roma Tre University Laurea Magistrale - year 5). The Roma Tre University students shall obtain not less than 60 ECTS credits at the Financial University.

The students selected by the Financial University as the Program participants shall attend the second year (2 semesters) of the Double Degree at the Roma Tre University (Financial University Master Degree program - year 2). The Financial University students shall obtain not less than 60 ECTS credits at the Roma Tre University.

Students admitted to the Program shall be registered as students at their home institution during the whole period of study at the home institution. Students are granted full access to both Parties' facilities (e.g. libraries, laboratories, etc.) during the period of study.

At the host institution, students shall be allowed to do the following:

- a) Attend classes and take the prescribed formative tests at the end of courses taken;
- b) Pursue research aimed at producing the final thesis;
- c) Take part in a traineeship program, when this is the requirement of the curriculum of the Double Degree Program diploma seekers (for a maximum of 21 ECTS at the end of the traineeship period).

Each Party will keep records of the students registered on the Program and provide all students and each Party with the official transcript of records.

The credits earned at the host university during the Program period will be transferred to the home university according to the Double Degree Program study plan. The Program module mapping and study plans for each semester shall be described in Annex A hereto.

Students who failed at least one formative assessment examination at the Financial University are required to resit the respective examinations, yet only twice. Resit examinations will be provided and graded by Financial University, and cannot be retaken at Roma Tre University. If a student fails, at all three attempts, he or she cannot obtain a diploma at Financial University but he or she can continue the study at the home university.

Transferring credits shall be made using the ECTS system as described in Annex A. Courses transferred between the Parties must have a minimum passing grade or its equivalent (see Annex B). Courses will be transferred to the host institution as soon as the grades in the home institution are posted.

The study plan of the Program for each semester is described in Annex A to this Agreement. Upon completing the Double Degree Program and subject to meeting the Program requirements (i.e. 120 ECTS credits), the students will obtain two Diplomas as per the law of the Russian Federation and Italy and the Parties' by-laws:

- Master Degree in Law (program No. 40.04.01), with the concentration in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer) delivered by the Financial University, incl. the Diploma Supplement.
- Laurea Magistrale LMG/01 in Law delivered by the Roma Tre University and the Diploma Supplement.

The marking systems of the two Parties and the grade conversion system are described in Annex B to this Agreement.

Each Party authorizes the use of its name and logo for the purposes related exclusively to this Double Degree Program. Except as provided for in this Agreement, neither Party shall make use of the name of the other Party in any publication, advertisement or news release without prior consultation and written approval. Each Party will publicize the Double Degree Program in its promotional materials (the website, brochures) and will provide copies of the materials to the other Party.

Art. 6: Funding, Expenses, Insurance

The universities involved can cover the travel and living expenses of their professors sent abroad to the partner institution within the Double degree program. These business trips can also take place within the framework of other mobility programs.

The students involved can apply for scholarships or other financial aid instruments to cover the costs caused by their participation in the Double degree program. Fees not specifically covered by this agreement, and the cost of housing and meals, shall be borne by the students themselves.

Medical assistance as well as health and accident insurance will be dealt with in accordance to the legislations of the countries involved.

Both parties commit to verify the existence of basic insurance and assistance related coverage. If medical assistance or health and accident insurance are not regulated by international agreements among the countries involved, each student participating in programs under this agreement shall be required by his or her university to purchase sufficient health and accident insurance for the duration of his or her participation

Art. 9: Evaluation and Teaching Methodology

During the study period, participating students will take part in the teaching activities of the receiving institution as they are regularly carried out. They will be evaluated according to the criteria and with the methodology regularly used at the receiving university.

The participating students will be evaluated according to the same criteria as other students enrolled at the receiving university.

Art. 10: Dissertation, Thesis, Disquisition

Upon completing the course of the Double Degree Program, the Italian and Russian students shall take the state final examination, which will include the preparation and the defense procedure for the research thesis.

The final thesis is graded in accordance with the rules set in Italy and the Russian Federation. The final thesis must be submitted by the students at the end of the second year of the Program. Each of the Parties (Roma Tre University and the Financial University) shall appoint an examination board according to current regulations of each of the Parties. Each of the examination boards will assess the final thesis. The students shall write their final thesis in English. A copy of the final thesis is to be submitted to both Parties.

The Partners agree to mutually recognize the thesis done at the Roma Tre University and the Financial University and to recognize the results of examinations and the grades (according to Annex B).

Art. 11: Requirements for Awarding the Degree

The requirements necessary in order to obtain the double degree are specifically regulated by arts. 5 and 10, and applicable Annexes.

Art. 12: Settlement of Controversies

Controversies concerning the interpretation and fulfilment of the agreed terms and conditions will be settled by mutual consent. If necessary, the settlement of controversies shall be entrusted to an Arbitration Panel composed by three members, one appointed respectively by each party, and the third chosen by mutual consent.

Art 13: Duration and Termination

The Agreement shall become effective from the date of signing by both Parties be in force for an initial period of six academic years, starting from 2022/2023 academic year. Thereafter, it shall be automatically extended for an additional period of six years at each expiration date unless either institution provides written notice to terminate the agreement a minimum of twelve months prior to the expiration date. Any termination or amendment to the agreement must not interfere with programme operation at either institution, nor have any negative effect on any participant whose study extends beyond the termination date.

Art. 14: Final Clauses

This Agreement is made in 6 original copies each having equal legal force, 2 of them in English, 2 in Russian, and 2 in Italian, 3 original copies for each of the Parties.

Annexes A and B are an integral part of this agreement. Both parties will receive a

copy in each language. All misinterpretations will be settled by mutual consent.

Art. 15: Data Protection

The use of personal data is regulated by the new European Regulation n. 679 - 27.4.2016 – GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) as well as current national legislation of Italy and the Russian Federation.

ANNEX A: Program Description

Program name: Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer)

Level: Master

Program starting date: 2022/2023 academic year

Program duration: 2 years

Learning mode: face-to-face mode

Language of instruction: English

Tuition fee

The Program participants will obtain a tuition fee waiver from both host institutions based on a mutual agreement between the parties. The Program participants shall pay their tuition fee in their home institutions in accordance with the Parties' by-laws during the period when they participate in the Program.

List of documents to be provided before enrolment

The list of documents necessary for registration of international students in the Financial University:

A) A copy of the national's passport that is certified by a notary public and that is valid for at least 18 months starting from the date of issue of the student entry visa;

B) The original of an academic transcript where all courses taken during all academic semesters are indicated and its translation into Russian that is certified by a notary public (the translation can be certified by a stamp of the foreign education institution);

C) A certificate stating that a student is studying in Roma Tre University where the level of his academic program is indicated and its translation into Russian that is certified by a notary public (the translation can be certified by a stamp of the foreign education institution);

D) A certificate of prior learning from a school/college/post-secondary school and its translation into Russian that is certified by a notary public;

E) A medical insurance policy that is valid during the whole period of study and its translation into Russian that is certified by a notary public;

F) Medical certificates with all the key test results, incl. HIV/AIDS, syphilis and tuberculosis certificates, their translation into Russian that is certified by a notary public (for the student residence hall check-in procedure);

G) Four photographs (size: 3 x 4 cm) (upon arrival).

The list of documents necessary for registration of international students in Roma Tre University:

A) A copy of the national's passport that is valid for at least 18 months starting from the date of issue of the student entry visa;

B) The original of an academic transcript where all courses taken during all academic semesters are indicated and its translation into Italian that is certified by a notary public (the translation can be certified by a stamp of the foreign education institution);

C) A certificate stating that a student is studying in the foreign education institution where the level of his academic program is indicated and its translation into Italian that is certified by a notary public (the translation can be certified by a stamp of the foreign education institution);

D) A certificate of prior learning from a school/college/post-secondary school and its translation into Italian that is certified by a notary public.

Qualifications obtained

Upon completing the course at the Financial University, the students will obtain a degree of a master (program No. 40.04.01 in Law, with the concentration in Legal Support of Business Operations (Corporate Lawyer)).

Upon completing the course at the Roma Tre University, the students will obtain a degree of a master LMG/01 (Laurea Magistrale in Law).
