



ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Since 2015, IDP and the Università degli Studi Roma Tre have collaborated on joint initiatives in teaching, research, and community outreach in the field of Law. In December 2024, this partnership reached a new level with the signing of a Cooperation Agreement to implement a Joint Double Degree Program in Law.



Law students will be able to obtain both a Bachelor's Degree in Law from IDP and the equivalent degree from Università degli Studi Roma Tre in Italy (Laurea Magistrale a Ciclo Unico in Giurisprudenza).



Brazil has one of the largest demands for legal services in the world. The market is robust, diverse and offers opportunities in both the public and private sectors, with a high demand for specialists in areas such as: Business Law, Tax Law, Environmental Law, Arbitration and Mediation, and Digital Law and Data Protection.

Academic Excellence

IDP is one of the most renowned higher education institutions in Brazil, especially in the areas of Law, Public Policy, Administration and Economics. 
International Experience

The university values the integration of international students, fostering a highly international and multicultural academic community. Additionally, Brasília holds several Administrative Infrastructure in which students can access and collaborate in several ways.

Brasília also is home to thousands of law firms, government agencies, higher courts and autonomous institutions. For international law students, this means multiple internship opportunities, high-level academic events and connections with influential legal professionals.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

The program operates in four stages:



Stage One

Selected students through Università degli Studi Roma Tre's selection process will study one academic year in Brasília (two semesters), following a study plan defined jointly with the partner university.

Stage Two

Courses successfully completed in IDP will be credited toward the student's academic curriculum at Università degli Studi Roma Tre.

Stage Three

The final thesis (TCC) will be supervised by a professor from each institution and written in Portuguese or English.

Stage Four

Upon approval of the thesis, IDP will issue the Bachelor of Law diploma recognized by the Brazilian government, and Università degli Studi Roma Tre will issue the Laurea Magistrale a Ciclo Unico in Giurisprudenza, recognized by the Italian government and valid throughout the European Union.
